Drum Major Verbal Commands

Commands are always given in tempo and spoken rhythmically so that execution occurs together. Commands are based on a 4 beat measure plus the next down beat execution of the command. They are broken into 3 parts, Call, Command, and Execution.

Call to Attention:	Call De-tail Atten 1 & 2 & 3 &	Command Hut 2 4&	Execution Snap to attention 1
Instruments up:	Call Horns up and 1 & 2& 3&	-	Execution Snap horns up 1
Mark Time:	Call Mark time 1& 2&	Command mark 3& 4&	Step
Forward March:	Call For-ward 1 & 2&	Command March 3& 4&	Execution Step 1
Backward March:	Call Back step 1& 2&	Command march 3& 4&	Step
Turns:	Call Right turn 1& 2&	Command hoe 3& 4&	Execution <i>Turn</i> 1
Halt:	Call De-tail 1 & 2&	Command halt 3& 4&	Execution <i>Halt</i> 1

On the "and" of beat four is where the movement actually begins for marching commands, i.e. knee-break and weight shift.
